- 2. Provide a current official transcript certified by school or college registrar.
- 3. High school applicants should submit letters of recommendation from two of the following, while **College applicants** should submit **only** (b) and (c).
- a) senior, junior or dual credit college English instructor high school applicants only.
- b) publication adviser or local newspaper supervisor student has been employed
- c) from a person of the applicant's choice (publication employer or adviser preferred)
- 4. All applicants should submit digital or print clips of published work. Include publication dates. May send photocopies of work as published in yearbook or magazine. Please mount all photocopies and newspaper clippings on paper and place in folder or binder **IF** submitting hardcopy.
